Abstracts should be submitted in English.

Length of abstracts: 250-300 words, including the title and 5 keywords.

Bibliographical references should follow, although they are not included in the word count. The abstract should contain aims, theoretical framework, methodology, analysis, results and conclusions.

The author's name should be removed from the title and from references to earlier publications.
